

Setapuktuk Wind Project

A Major Milestone in Nova Scotia's Clean Energy Future



The Setapuktuk Wind Project, co-developed by EverWind and Membertou, received Environmental Assessment approval from the Nova Scotia Department of Environment and Climate Change in November 2025.

Setapuktuk — the Mi'kmaq word for Guysborough (pronounced Set-Tuh-Puck-Took) — is a 432 MW onshore wind project that will generate clean electricity to produce green hydrogen and ammonia for both domestic and international markets.

Located near Pirate Harbour, Middle Melford, Sand Point, Hadleyville, and Manchester in the Municipality of the District of Guysborough, the project layout has been refined through improvements in wind technology, ongoing studies, and community input, reducing the number of turbines from 84 to 54. This allows for a smaller footprint, with fewer access roads and less land disturbance, while maintaining the project's clean energy capacity and local benefits.

Advancing Nova Scotia's Clean Energy Future

The Guysborough Wind Projects — including Setapuktuk, Wind Farm 2, and Wind Farm 3 — represent Phase 2 of EverWind's renewable energy buildout to power its Point Tupper Green Fuels Project facility in Nova Scotia. Together, these projects will help deliver green hydrogen and ammonia to global markets while strengthening Atlantic Canada's role as a clean energy leader.

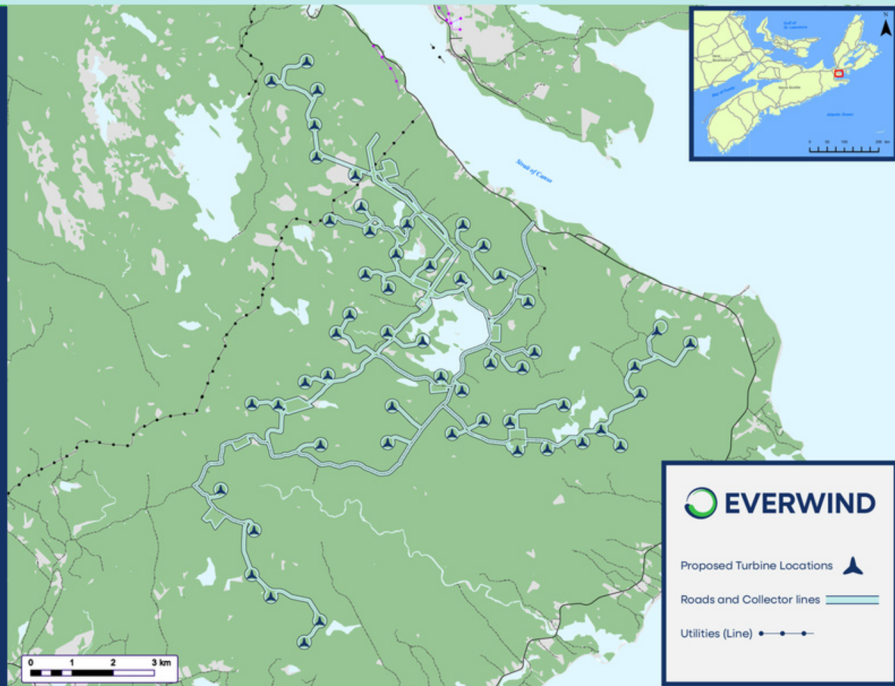
A key component of Phase 2 is the planned overhead transmission line crossing the Strait of Canso, which was approved through Nova Scotia's Environmental Assessment process in April 2025. This line will connect and deliver renewable power from the Guysborough wind farms to the Point Tupper facility.

Community Benefits

Setapuktuk will deliver lasting benefits to Guysborough County and beyond:

- 350–400 construction jobs and 20–35 long-term operations jobs
- Over \$3 million in annual indexed tax revenue for MODG
- \$432,000 annually through a Community Benefits Fund supporting community priorities like infrastructure, recreation, and education
- Local employment, training, and procurement opportunities through a Community Benefits Agreement with MODG

Developed in partnership with Membertou Development Corporation, Setapuktuk reflects EverWind's commitment to Mi'kmaq partnership, reconciliation, and shared prosperity.
